Meet Surcharge



Is required to be able to balance our budget

Each swimmer will be charged \$5 per meet

Collected by increasing the current meet admin charge from \$2 to \$7

Starting immediately after the general meeting in March





What we need from parents



We would like to afford to do banquets and picnics
We would like to provide T shirts for "free"
We just do not have the money to do what we would like to do

Pay your \$100 per family membership fee

Coral Springs is \$100 per swimmer

Meet admin charge moves from \$2 to \$7 (so the booster club gets \$5 per swimmer per meet)

Coral Springs charges \$8

Help attract sponsorship for heat sheets, meets or events

Full page heat sheet is just \$100

Support fundraisers

Coupon books only 60% participation

Volunteer at home meets

Not being able to run the grill is lost income for us Only 36% of families volunteered at January's meet





Volunteer Hours vs Volunteer Recognition



The board believes that minimum hours is not a positive approach

We still have families who do hundreds of hours We still have families who do nothing

We are considering a volunteer recognition program

T Shirts, hats etc would be awarded for achieving a certain number of hours

This also creates a great brand around our pool deck





Alignment with Coral Springs Booster Club
